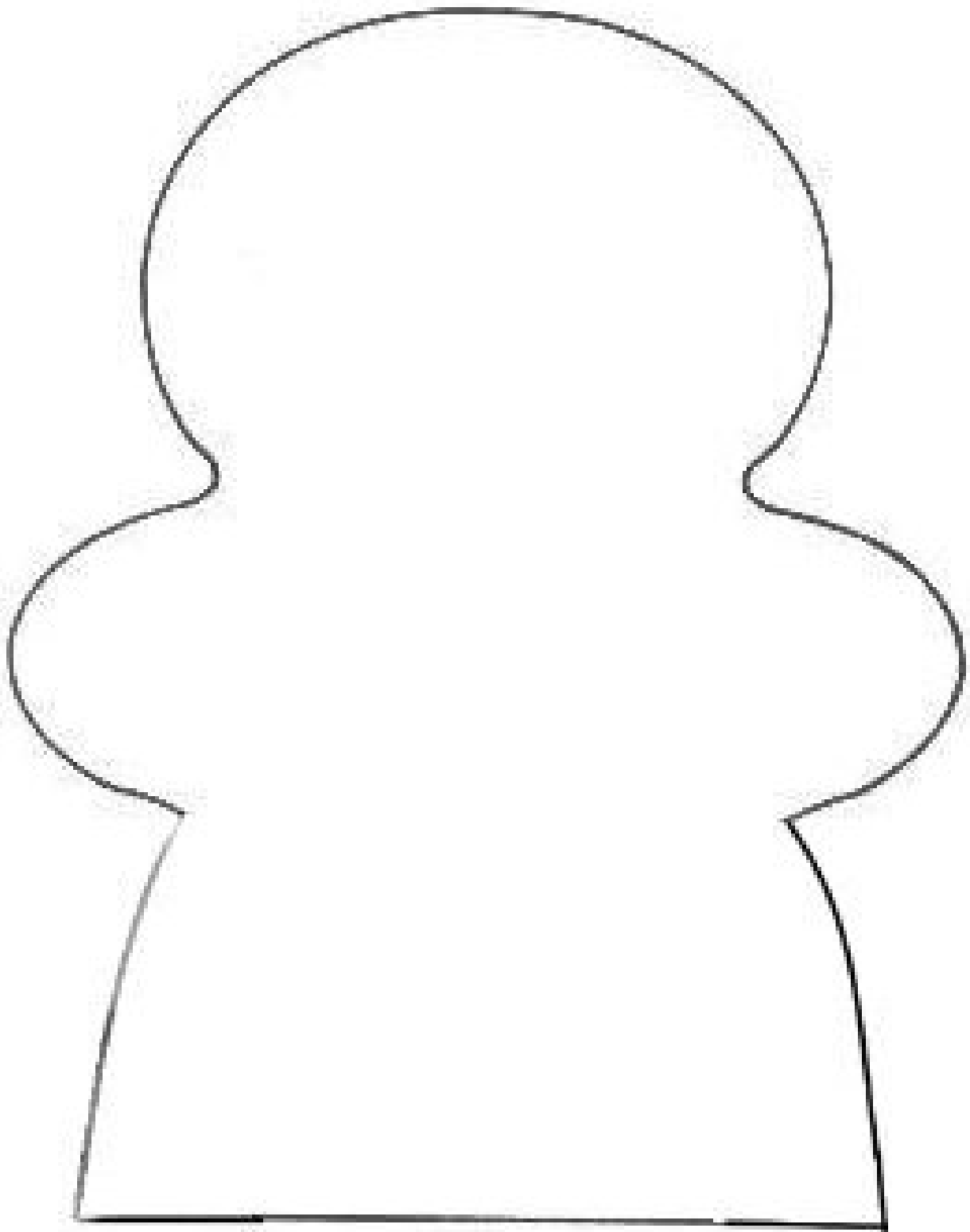
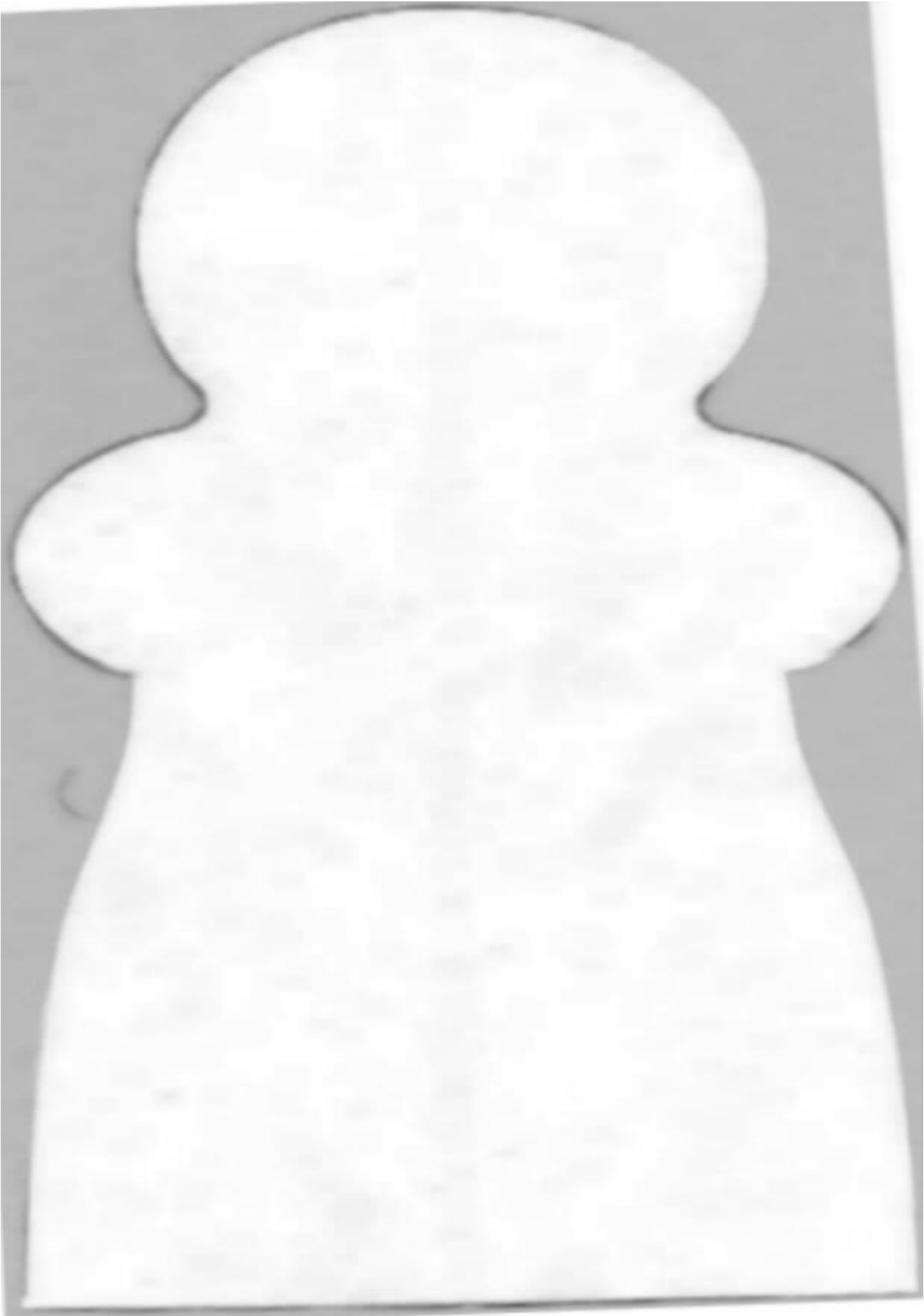
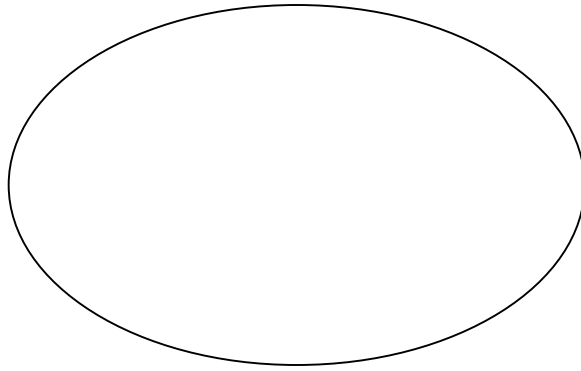


SMALL PUPPET BODY – For Child’s Hand / LARGE PUPPET BODY – For
Adult Hand

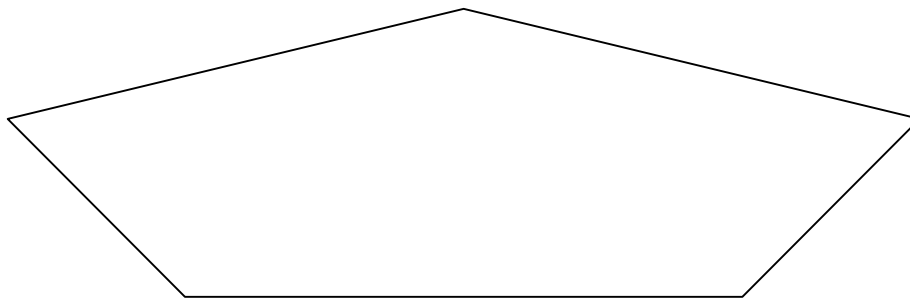




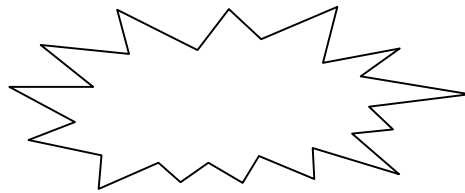
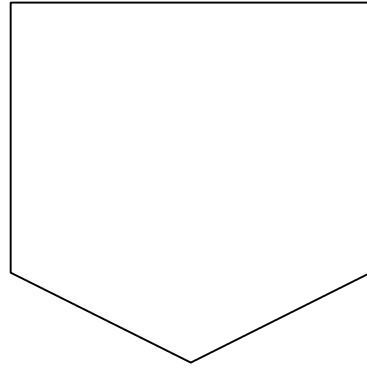
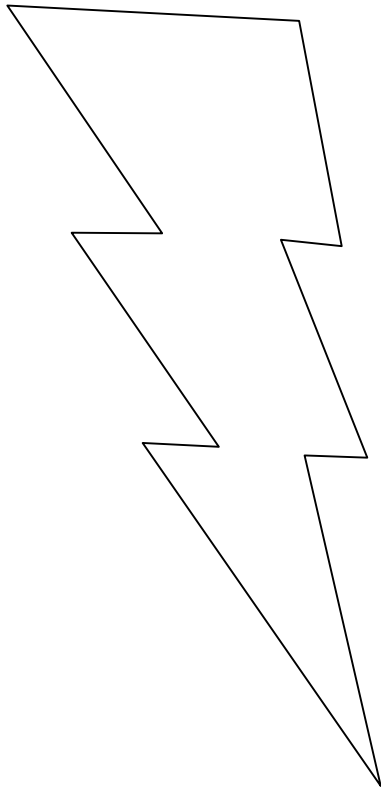

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The smaller sized puppet is great for a child or small woman's hand. If you find the puppet too small for your purpose we recommend using the larger pattern. To avoid the possibility of wasting good material, we 'tested' the size by pinning two paper patterns together.

We used felt for our puppets bodies but encourage you to be creative in your material choices!

Please share a picture if possible with us. We'd love to see what you and your children have done!

*IMPORTANT

Gluing can be a messy process. To avoid the front and back from sticking together from excess glue we inserted a piece of cardboard into our puppet while working with it.

1. Cut two, front and back, of the body. With wrong sides together, stitch 1/8 to 1/4 inch from the side. If the puppet is too large you can have a much more generous stitching length.
2. Cut out the face and glue to front side of puppet. Crown and beard are optional
3. Be creative and have fun decorating!
